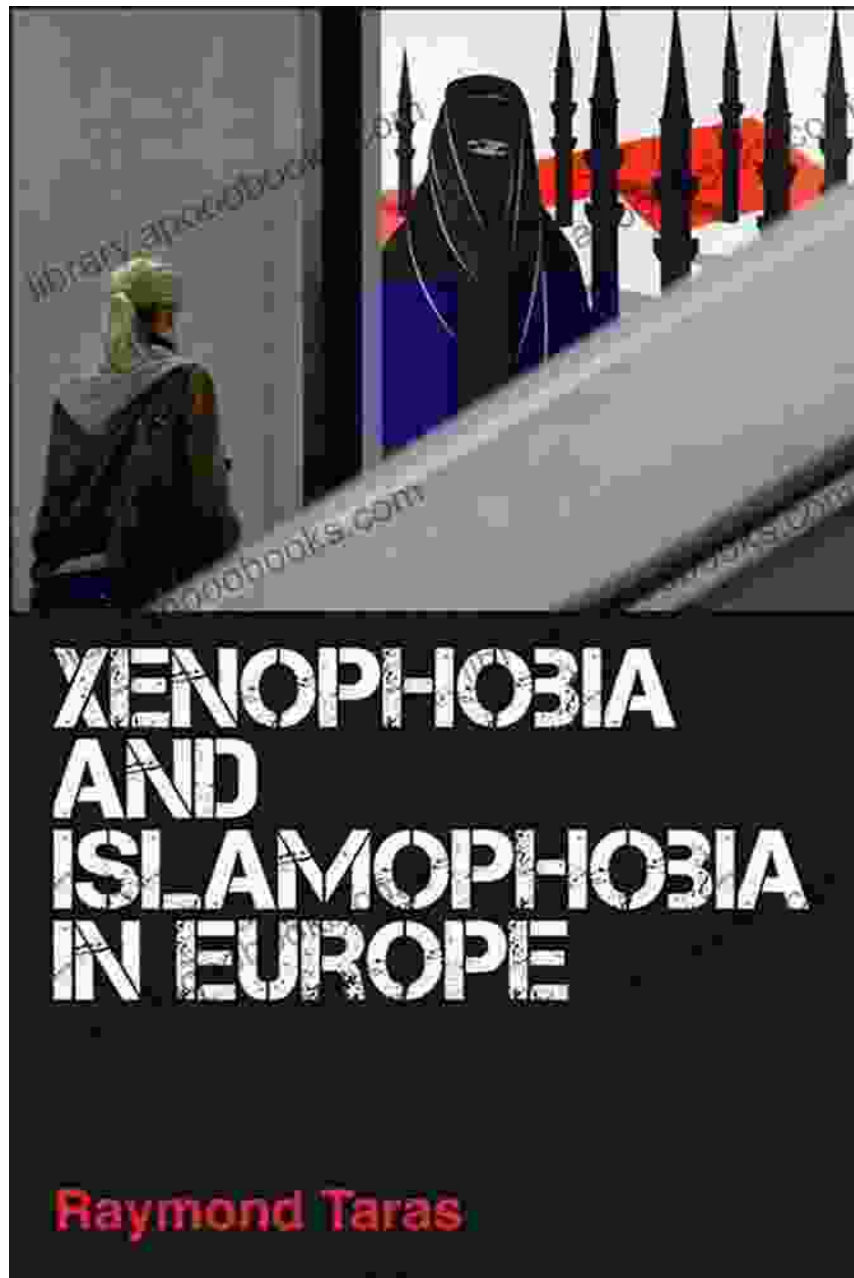

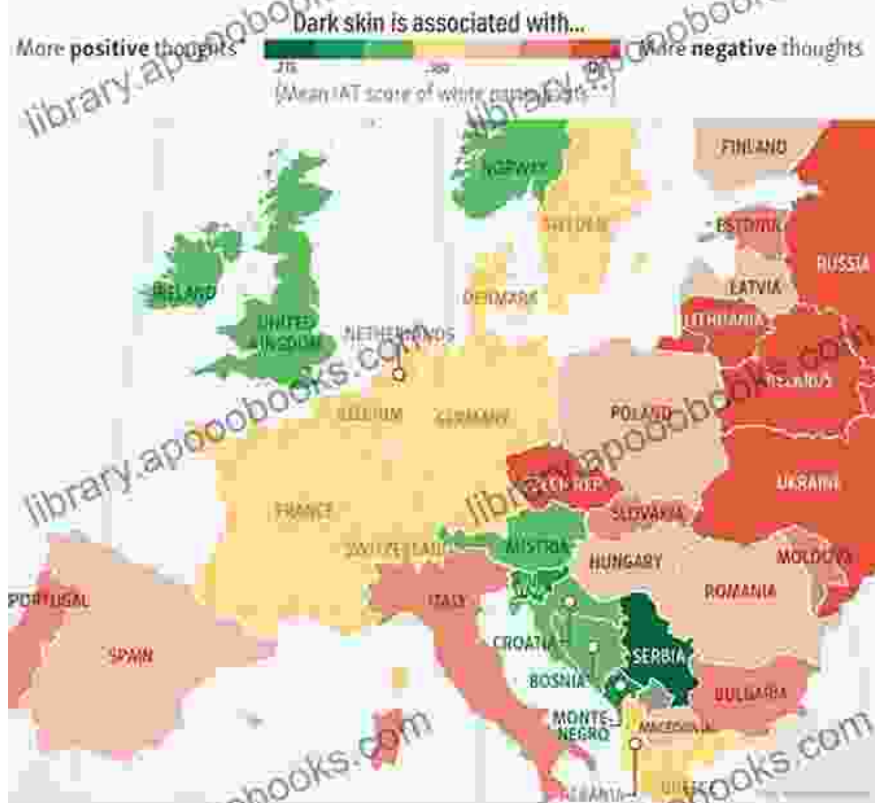

Note: The data is based on a total sample size of 288,176 white Europeans collected by Project Implicit between 2002 and 2015.

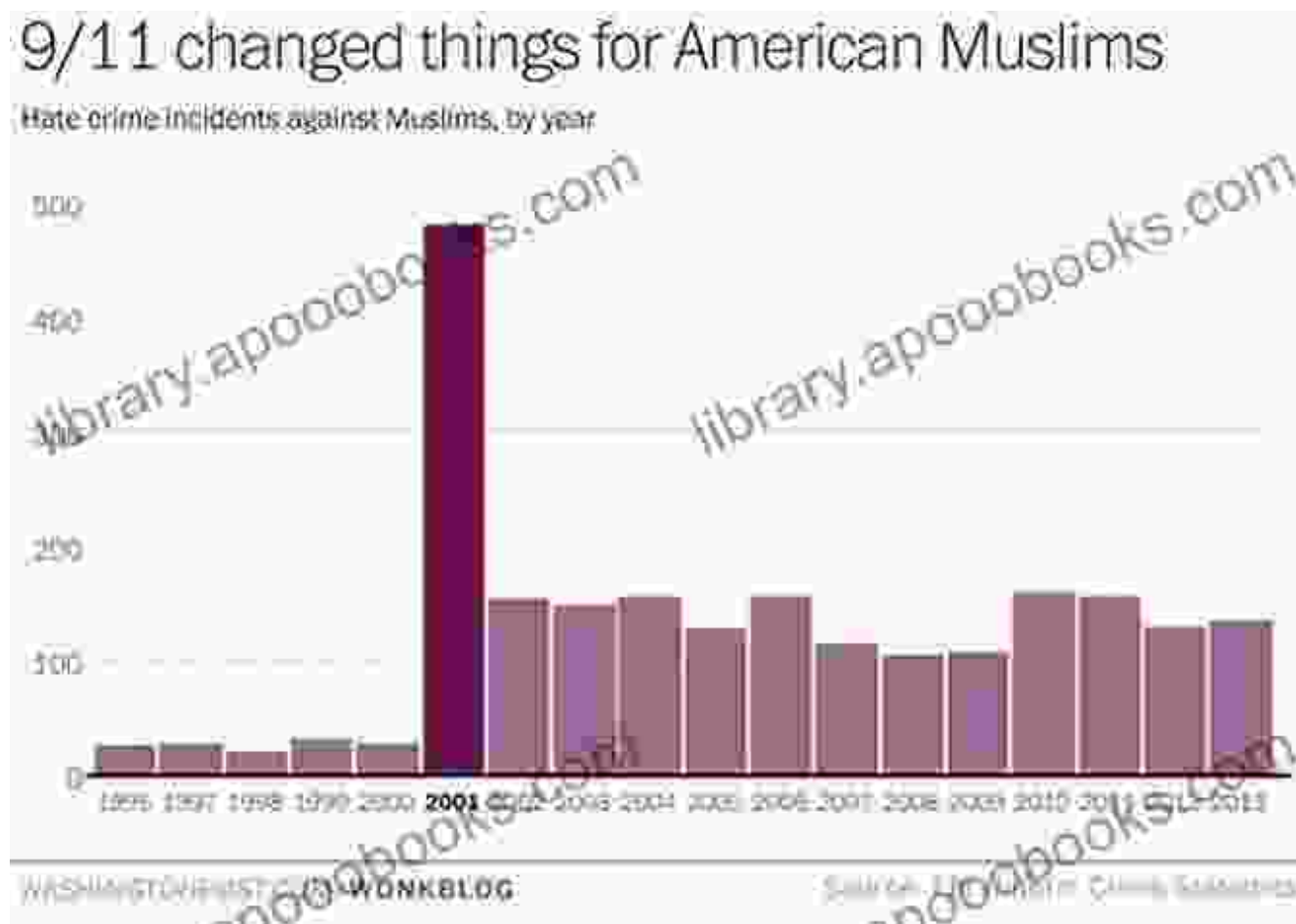

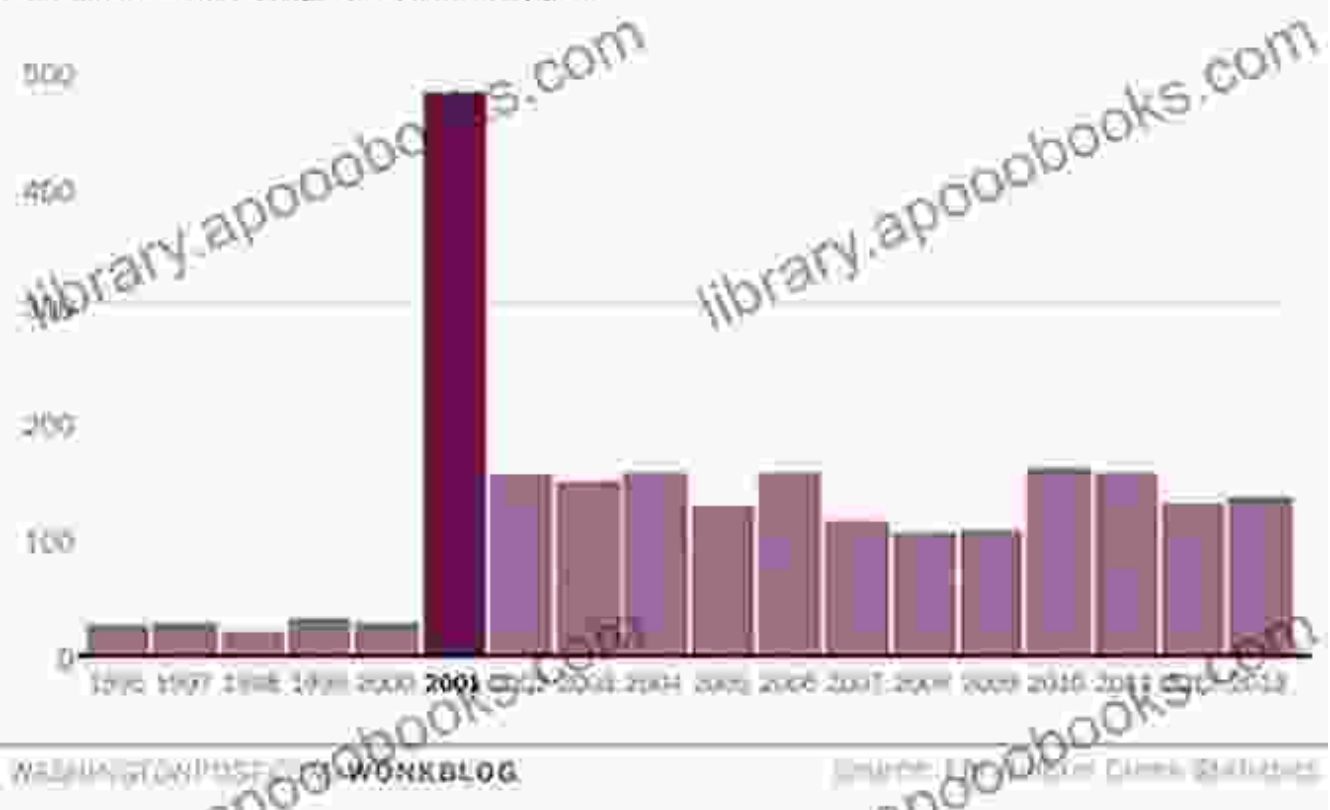

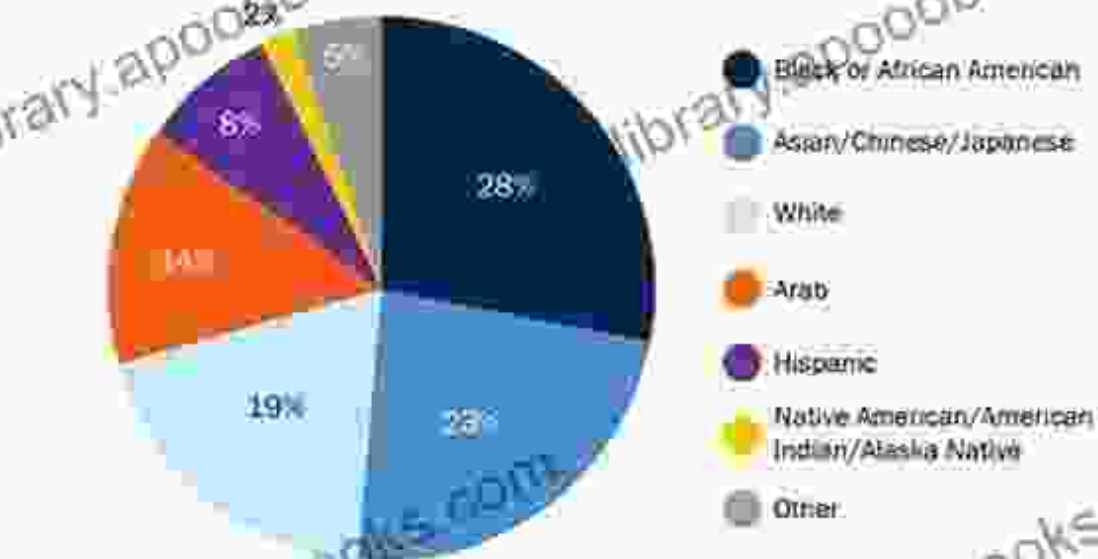
