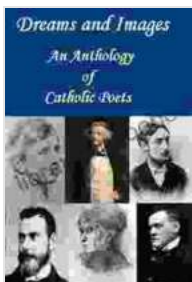

About the Editors

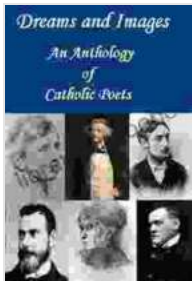
Dreams and Images was edited by two of the most respected Catholic poets of our time, Dana Gioia and Kevin Bowen.
