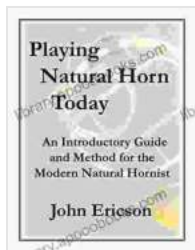

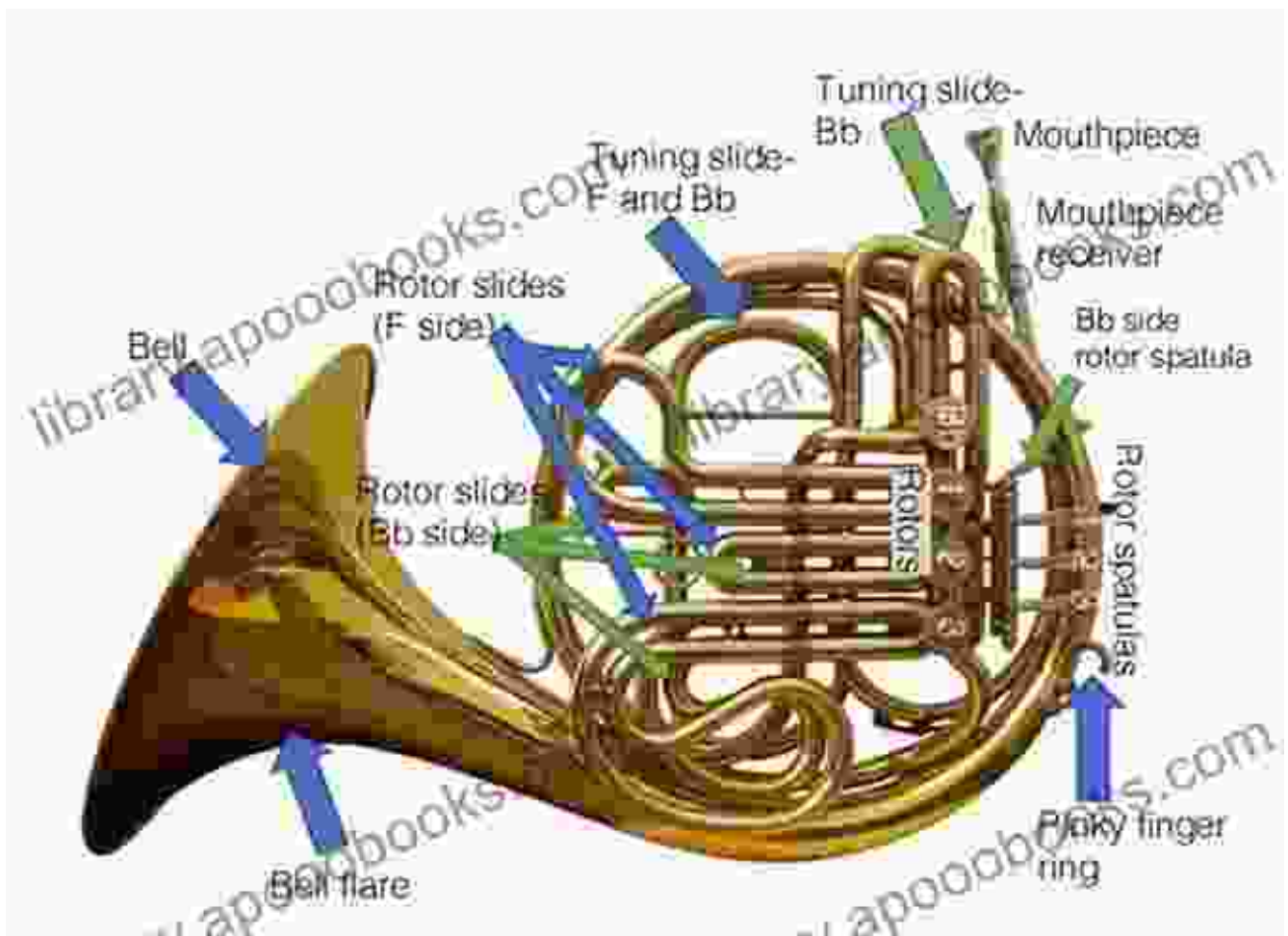

Place the mouthpiece on the top lip and fit between the lower lip and the "A" area while keeping your bottom lip...

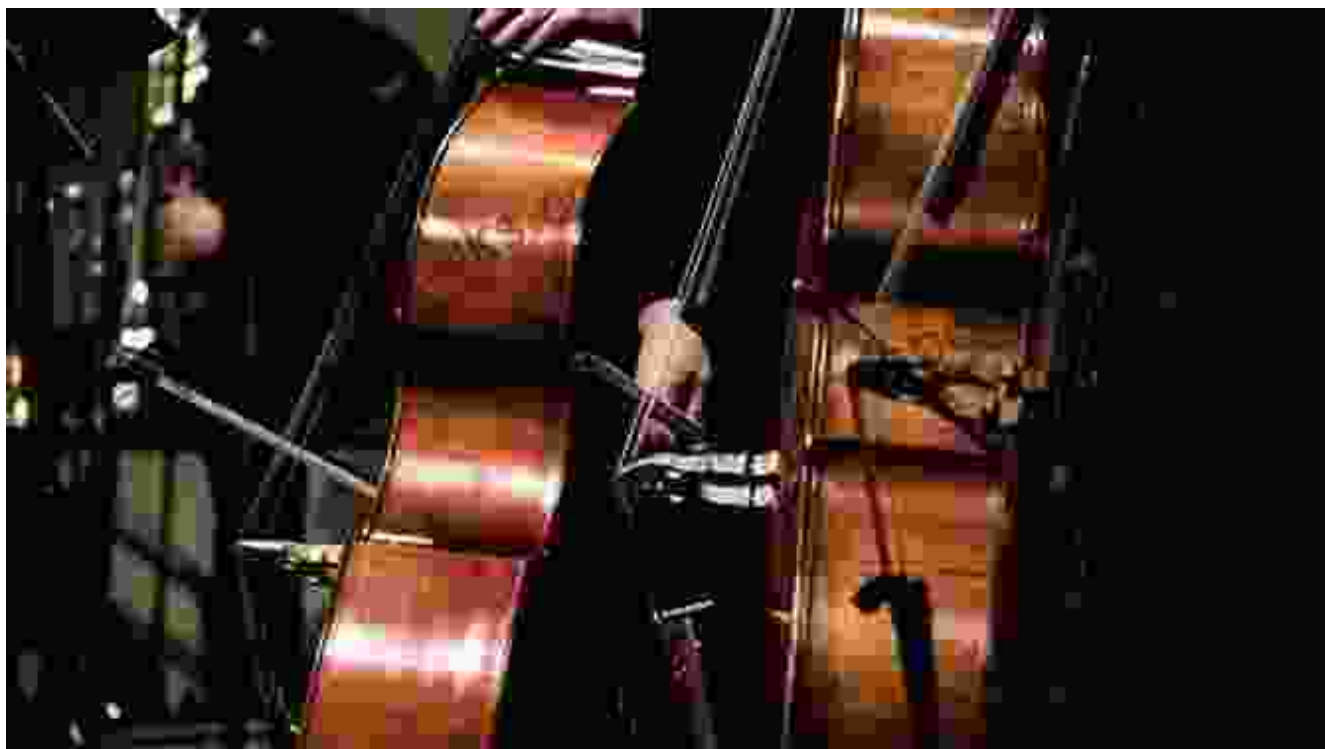

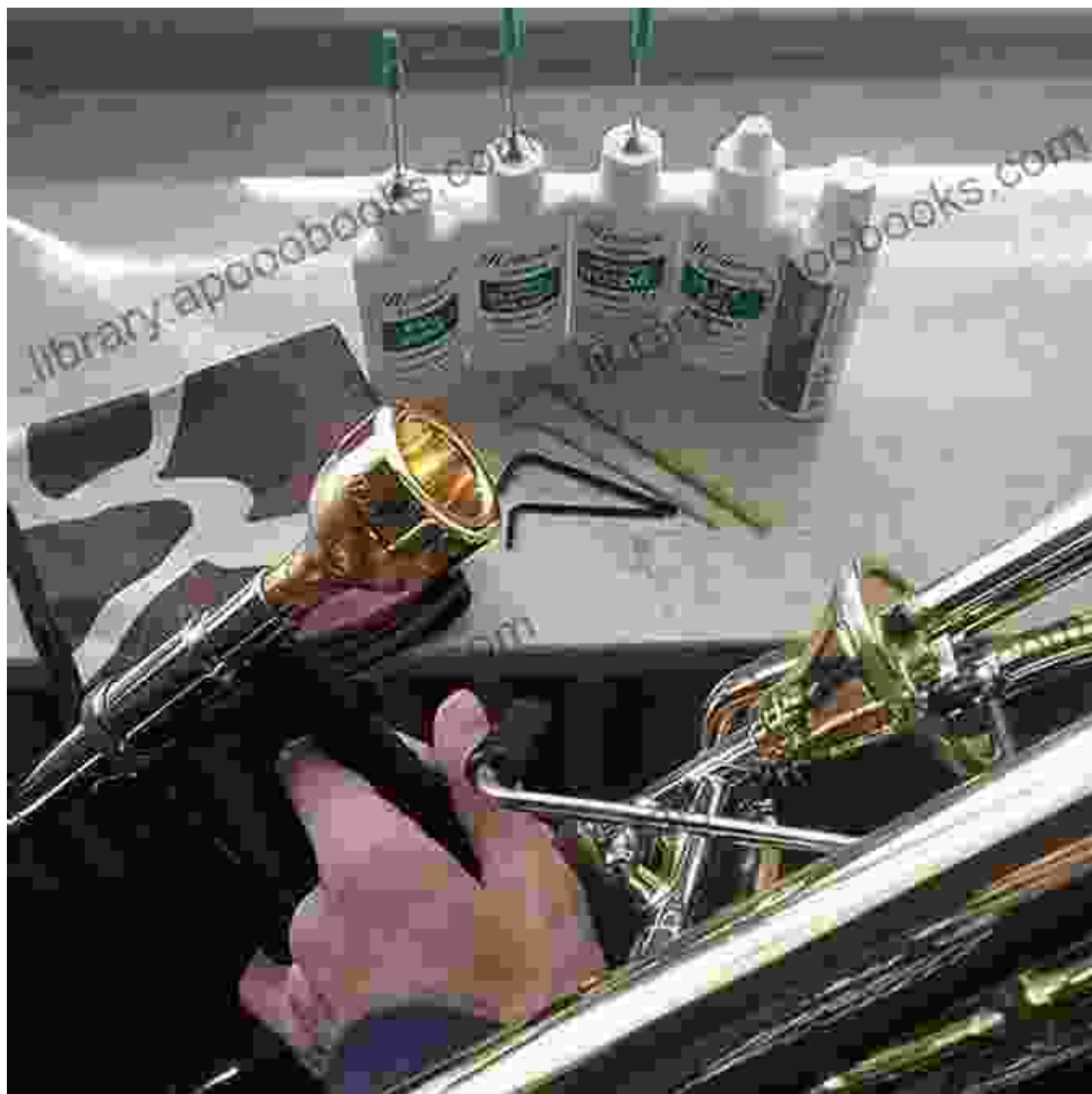

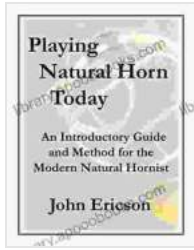
