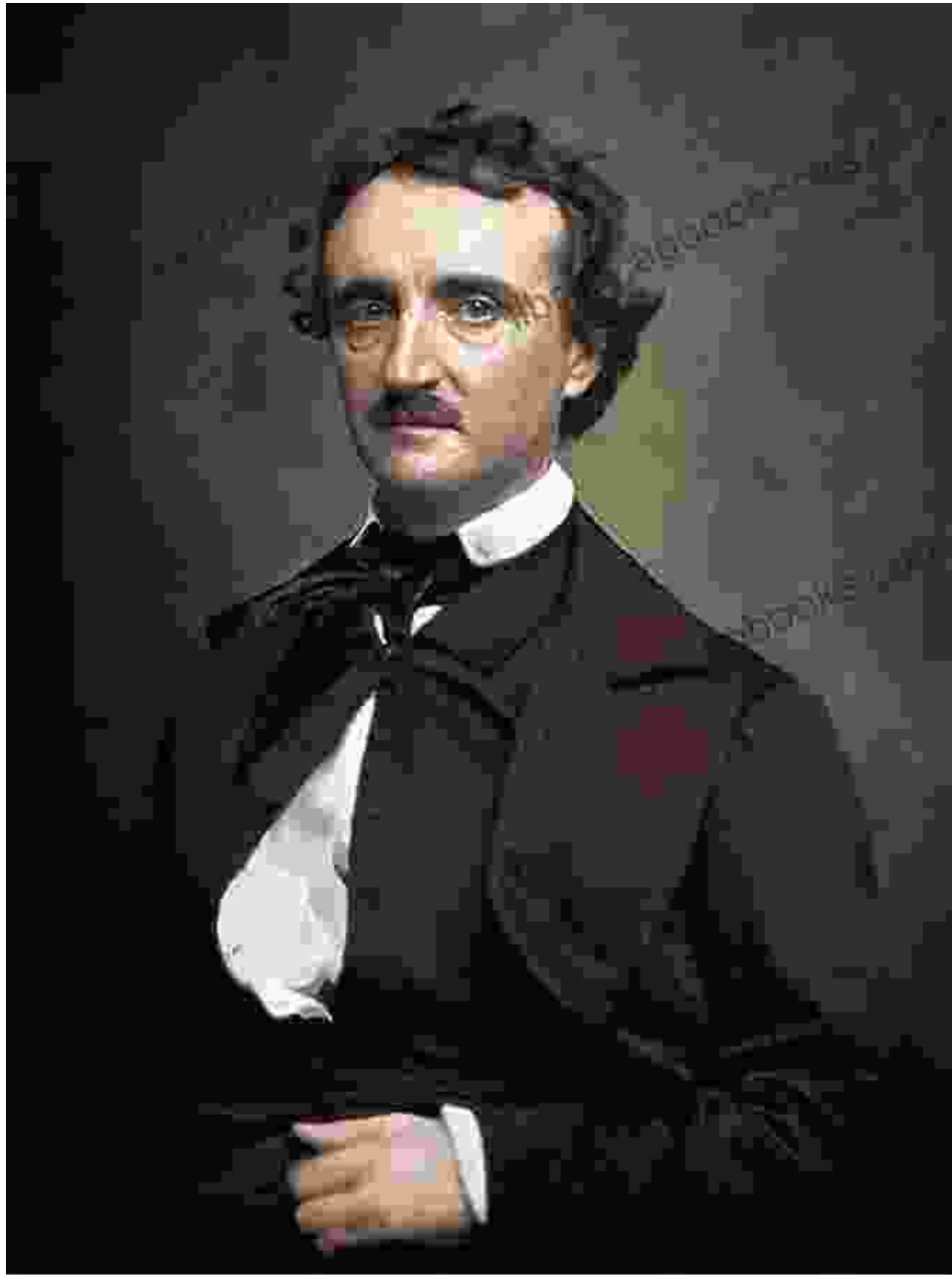


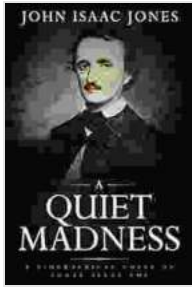

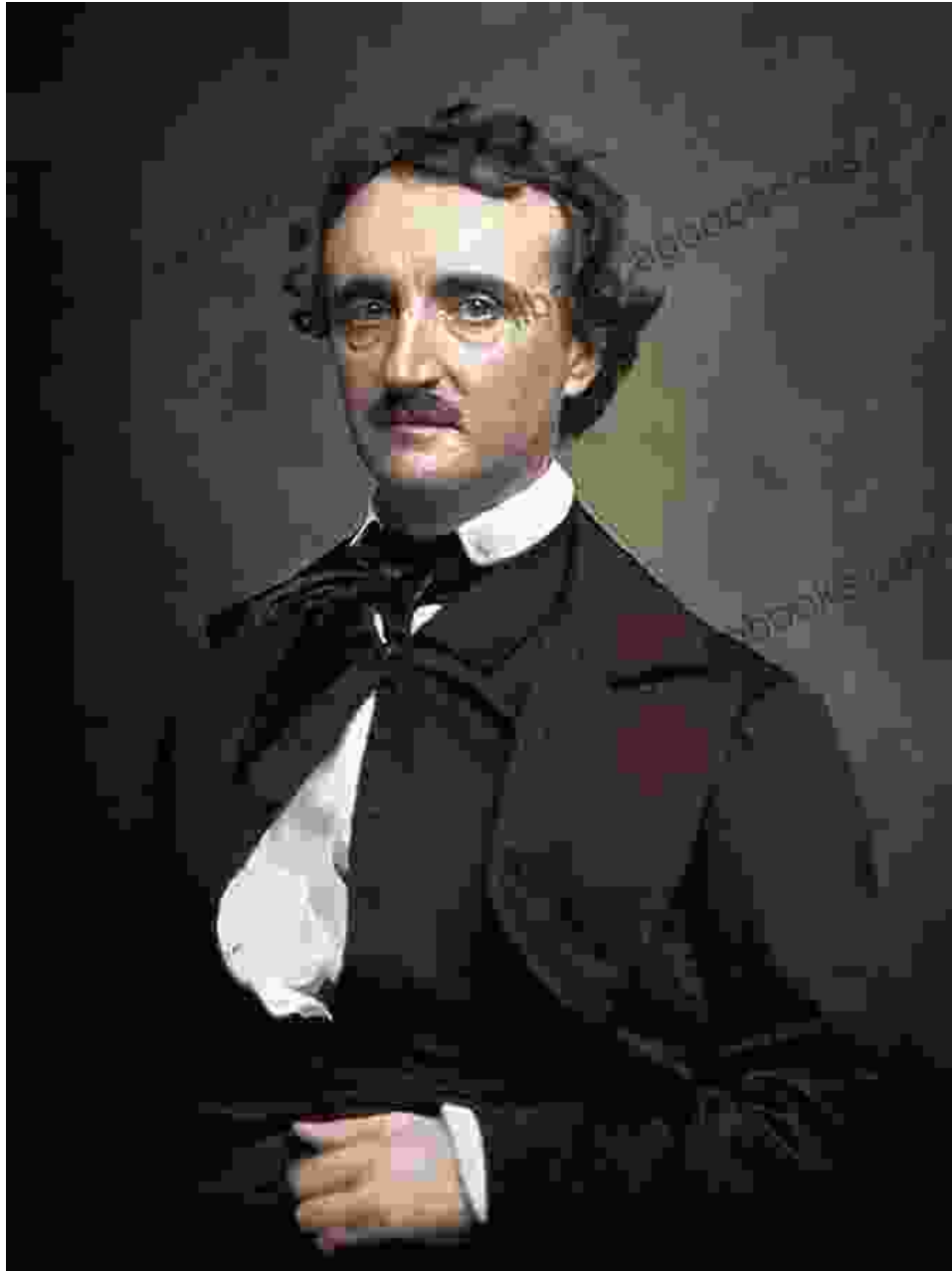
Once upon a midnight dreary, while I pondered, weak and weary,

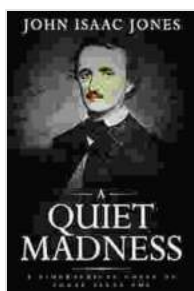
