

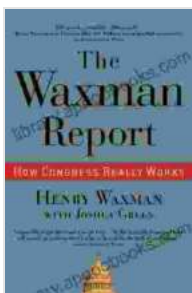

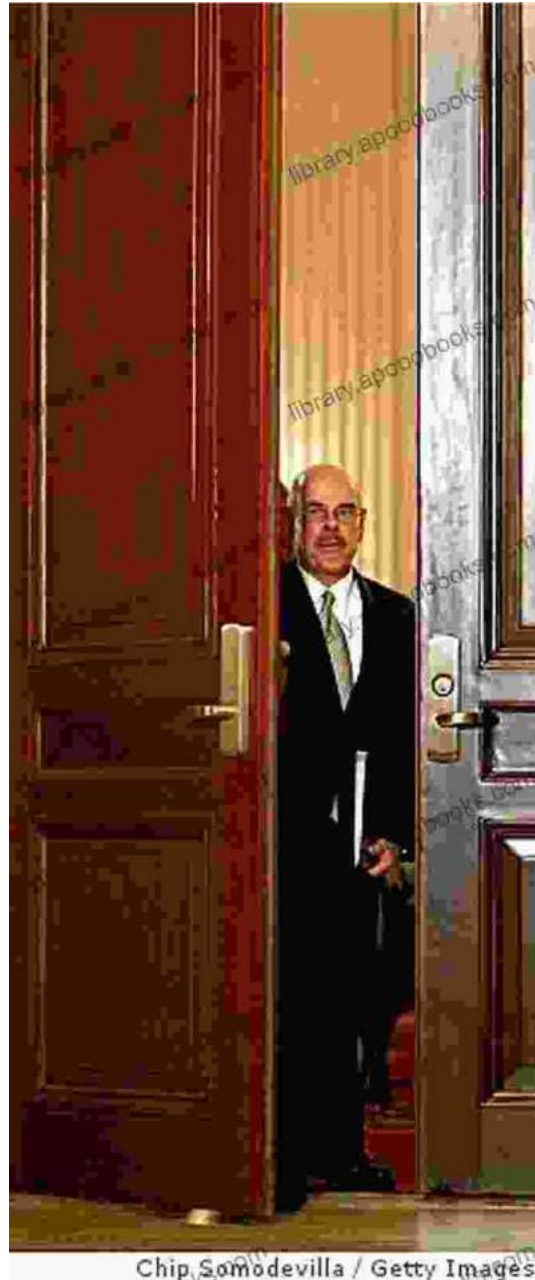

A donor meeting is a guided conversation that is well planned and follows a logical pattern. When you want to allow the conversation to unfold, you need to set the process to you, achieve the goals for the meeting.

Goals for the Meeting

Share project concept
- 

Gather feedback on project
- 

Identify what most excites them
- 

Clarify level of interest and possible commitment to project

- ### 1. Opening

Thank them for their time, acknowledge and thank for their past support, update them on what their past gifts have made possible. State the goals for meeting.
- ### 2. Organization Update

Explicitly you are going to tell them about a new project. Briefly describe the project. Focus on benefits, not just features of the project. Talk about why this project matters and why it is important to you and the community. Watch the clock, and keep this part of the meeting at 5 minutes or less.
- ### 3. Key Questions

Your first goal is to get them to speak and get their feedback on the project.

 - What is the most compelling part of this project?
 - What questions or concerns do you have about this project?
 - What's still unclear about this project?
 - What do you think would make someone want to support this project?

Hint: How they answer these questions gives insight into what part of the project speaks to them.
- ### 4. Listening

Your role after asking questions is to listen. Do not respond with specific answers right away. Think about the question part of the meeting as an invitation to start a dialogue. You will want to answer and clarify details, but hold back. Give them the space to share.
- ### 5. Handling Objections

Most of us become defensive when criticized, discouraged or hard questions are asked about our project. Remember that these are just questions formed as a statement. Listen for the passion behind the statement.
- ### 6. Take Time to Respond


Now is the time to circle back to respond to some of the questions or concerns they raised. Never get into a debate.
- ### 7. Asking for Commitment

The biggest fundraising mistake you can make is not asking for the gift. Ask the donor directly if this project is something they could see themselves supporting. Use the gift that is a good fit for the donor. When you ask, be sure they get the gift that they can or can't be uncomfortable with. Give them the support time to discuss their choice.
- ### 8. Ending Well

Close the meeting by thanking the donor for their time and their feedback. Close the meeting with a commitment to follow up with the prospect and their follow through. It is a gift to verify, provide, establish the terms of fulfillment and the next step in the process.

If a prospect is justified ask the reason for the decision. Always thank the prospect for considering the opportunity. Don't minimize that. No means not now. Don't assume a future rebuild will happen and that they become someone in the future to grow including sharing of the request and personal circumstances.

Remember, people enjoy conversations most when they talk the most.

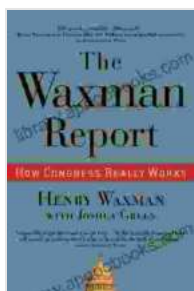
